

## RECENT PROJECTS

### QUALITY HOTEL - PLYMOUTH



The Quality Hotel has been a highly sensitive project for Plymouth City Council. Gilpin assumed responsibility for the site in January 2016. The Hotel held large quantities of asbestos which was transported to Swindon for disposal. The site had a 34 week program, facing many problems for Gilpin to resolve. Gilpin worked closely with Plymouth City Council to accommodate MTV crashes and various other key events leading through 2016.

### PALACE COURT - PLYMOUTH



In late 2015 Plymouth College of Art purchased Palace Court close to Plymouth's Barbican site on the Hoe with a view to overhaul the site into a dedicated teaching and exhibition campus for creative extended diploma students. Before the major refurbishment of the site could commence, Gilpin Environmental had to remove over 1500m<sup>2</sup> of asbestos sprayed coatings. Imposed with very strict deadlines, Gilpin worked extensively with both the client and appointed analytical laboratory and successfully completed the project on schedule.

## RECENT PROJECTS CONT

### WHITTON STATION - LONDON



As part of a major regeneration starting in February 2015, Whitton Station underwent a massive refurbishment as part of a joint venture between Richmond Council, RFU (Rugby Football Union) and the Department for Transport. Gilpin Environmental Ltd and sister company Sam Gilpin Demolition Ltd undertook the asbestos removal and demolition over multiple phases. The planned asbestos removal works were completed prior to the Rugby World Cup which was being held between September and October 2015.

### BECKLEY COURT - PLYMOUTH



Gilpin Environmental undertook the large scale removal of asbestos containing materials throughout six-stories including removal of licensed insulation materials throughout the basement. This allowed Sam Gilpin Demolition Ltd to follow on behind and demolish the existing six-storey building as part of a £29.5m contract. With the asbestos removal and demolition completed, Kier Construction are currently constructing a new 22-storey student accommodation which will become the tallest building in Plymouth.
